Economic Development Update from Battle Creek Unlimited

The new year is looking bright with three high-profile projects set to come on-line in 2019. New Holland Brewing; Heritage Tower and Record Box LLC are all slated t



and Record Box, LLC are all slated to be under construction and in full-service within the same year.

In October, **New Holland** closed on the sale of 64 W. Michigan along with a portion of the parking lot directly behind the building. The parking lot portion of the sale is slated to be an outside beer garden with many fun features; including seating for 100. The City Commission will be considering an OPRA tax abatement for the property in early 2019. Construction activity should commence soon with an anticipated opening slated for summer of 2019.

Heritage Tower too has made significant progress with the final piece of the capitol stack finalized on November 27, when the Michigan Strategic Fund Board approved \$10 million in project financing. This was the final piece of funding needed to get this project off the ground. This project has been a total community effort with several local partners including the MEDC; City of Battle Creek; the W.K. Kellogg Foundation; The Battle Creek Community Foundation; Heritage tower BC, LLC; the Direct Investment Fund Committee; the Battle Creek Brownfield Redevelopment Authority; the DDA, BCU; and South Bend based 1st Source Bank. Occupancy of the apartment units is slated for spring/summer 2019.

Record Box, LLC will also be under construction and is slated to be open by fall 2019. This project is located at 15 Carlyle Street and is being developed by Restore (269). The three-story building will include office space, event space, and a brewery in the garden level of the facility.
